MINUTES OF MEETING

FEBRUARY 17, 2020

The Commission suggested that it would be beneficial to have a conversation with the various sports organizations regarding a code of conduct for coaches and spectators. It was suggested that we post that code of conduct on the recreation page of the borough website as well. At the next meeting, Mr. Patterson will present a Code of Conduct for review.

Mr. Patterson indicated that online registration will begin for men's and women's softball and volleyball. Regarding the adult soccer program, he is still trying to determine if the participation is there to warrant the program.

The basketball program is mid-way through the season with no issues. The wrestling program will be finishing up in the next two weeks.
