

RAMSEY POOL COMMISSION
MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING, WEDNESDAY, APRIL 3, 2019

A special meeting of the Pool Commission was called to order on Wednesday, April 3, 2019, at 8:30 p.m. by Mr. Bach. Also present were Mrs. Hewitt, Mrs. Hoffman, Mr. Jost, Mrs. Maurer, Mrs. Suarez, Commission members, and Council Liaison Jones. Mr. Haskell and Mrs. Dey, Secretary, were absent.

In accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey, public notice of the meeting was published in The Record and posted in the Municipal Building.

The only topics to be discussed were the snack stand and the playground.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Chance Parker, 11 Park Place, asked about the progress of the new facility. Mr. Jones reminded Mr. Parker that the only topics to be discussed were the snack stand and playground and that there would be no questions about the construction.

DISCUSSION/PLAYGROUND

Mr. Bach handed out blue prints of the proposed playground. This has been a two-year project and has had much input from the community, professionals, and the Pool Commission. He presented all aspects of the playground.

Upon motion by Mr. Jost, seconded by Mrs. Hewitt, the plan for the playground was unanimously accepted as presented.

DISCUSSION/SNACK STAND

Pete and Mary's was awarded the bid at \$18,200; this was the same amount as last year. Mr. Bach let the commission know that Mike Sims, owner of Badlands Tacos in Ramsey, who has previously bid, declined to bid at the deadline. If the snack stand is not ready for opening day, there will be an agreement on a refund per diem and will be taken off Pete and Mary's total.

Upon motion by Mrs. Hewitt, seconded by Mrs. Hoffman, the contract for the snack stand for 2019 was unanimously awarded to Pete and Mary's with a bid of \$18,200.

ADJOURNMENT

Upon motion by Mr. Jost, seconded by Mrs. Maurer, and approved unanimously, the meeting was adjourned at 9:05 p.m.
