

RAMSEY POOL COMMISSION
MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING, WEDNESDAY, MAY 15, 2019

The monthly meeting of the Pool Commission was called to order on Wednesday, May 15, 2019 at 8:00 p.m. by Vice-Chairman Hewitt. Also present were Mrs. Hoffman, Mr. Jost, Mrs. Maurer, Commission members, Mr. Bach, Pool Manager, and Mrs. Dey, Secretary. Mr. Haskell, Mrs. Suarez, and Council Liaison Jones were absent.

In accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey, public notice of the meeting was published in The Record and The Ridgewood News and posted in the Municipal Building.

REPORT OF THE POOL MANAGER (AGENDA ITEMS)

The “early bird” rates had been extended to Wednesday, May 15th.

To date, 1,442 (2,126-2018) families, 281 (312) seniors, 24 (28) individuals, and 259 (226) out-of-towners have registered for the 2019 season, bringing in \$269,890 in comparison with \$334,390 on May 15, 2018, down approximately twenty percent.

The pool has been filled, chlorinated, and filtered. However, the gas line was cut during the ongoing construction and needs to be reattached by PSE&G. Consequently, the pool cannot be heated until that work is completed; currently the water is approximately fifty-five degrees. If the pool is not heated, it will not open.

Because of the weather, the sod has not been installed and the cement work for the pavilion has not been done. The new playground has also been delayed because of the rain.
