#### **PUBLIC HEARING:**

# Lithia Northeast Real Estate, LLC-BMW of Ramsey Block 4603, Lot 45.01 985 Route 17 South

**Mr. Whitaker** said that the applicant had noticed properly and the hearing could proceed.

James E. Jaworski, Esq. of Wells, Jaworski & Liebman, LLP, 12 Route 17 North, Paramus, N.J. appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Jaworski said that the applicant is proposing to modify the aesthetic of the building pursuant to the BMW corporate demands. Mr. Jaworski said there is a minor proposal to modify the building and the signage. Mr. Jaworski said that there are four (4) signs currently on the building that were previously approved. Mr. Jaworski said that when the signs were changed to read as "BMW of Ramsey" instead of "Prestige BMW", three (3) of the four (4) signs remained the same; however the letter "M" as a logo was added to the main front sign increasing it by 13 sf. Mr. Jaworski said that the variance they are requesting is for that additional 13 sf of signage which is currently in place on the building. Mr. Jaworski apologized to the Board on behalf of the applicant.

Mayor Dillon asked Mr. Jaworski if the applicant realized that the new signage was being installed. Mr. Jaworski said that they did realize that the "BMW of Ramsey" signage was being installed but they didn't realize that the letter "M" was being added to the signage. Mayor Dillon asked Mr. Jaworski if the applicant also owns the Toyota & Lexus dealerships. Mr. Jaworski said yes. Mayor Dillon asked Mr. Jaworski if they intend to change the signage on those dealerships. Mr. Jaworski said no. Mayor Dillon stated that if there are any future changes to the signage she hopes that the applicant will receive the required approvals. Mr. Jaworski said that he will convey her message to the applicant.

## **TESTIMONY OF MICHAEL DIPPLE**

**Michael Dipple** of L2A Land Design, LLC, 60 Grand Avenue, Englewood, N.J. was sworn in and deemed an expert in civil engineering. **Mr. Dipple** described the existing conditions and proposed façade improvements and alterations to the building signage. **Mr. Dipple** said that there are no site improvements proposed. **Mr. Dipple** said that the small building addition does not change the parking demand. There are no changes to the parking requirements for the site. The parking required for the facility is 531 spaces there are an existing 404 parking spaces on-site. **Mr. Dipple** said that they are proposing 71.7 sf where 58 sf is existing and 40 sf is maximum permitted.

#### **PUBLIC COMMENTS**

**Mr. Braggin** of Ramsey, N.J. asked **Mr. Dipple** if he was aware why the applicant increased the size of the sign without a hearing. **Mr. Dipple** said that he was not.

#### TESTIMONY OF VALDEMAR M. FRACZ

**Valdemar Fracz** of Environetics Group Architects, 180 Sylvan Avenue, Englewood Cliffs, N.J. was sworn in and deemed an expert in architecture. **Mr. Fracz** described Exhibit A-2. **Mr. Fracz** described the locations of existing four (4) façade signs. **Mr. Jaworski** asked **Mr. Fracz** if there is anything about the additional 13 sf that would be detrimental to public. **Mr. Fracz** said no.

# **PUBLIC QUESTIONS**

Mr. Braggin of Ramsey, N.J. asked Mr. Fracz to describe the signs. Mr. Fracz did so.

## **PUBLIC COMMENTS**

**Mr. Braggin** of Ramsey, N.J. was sworn in. **Mr. Braggin** said that he is in favor of the application based on the testimony.

**Chairman Iorio** stated that he while he appreciated that the application was a minor application he has concerns that applicant is appearing before the Board asking for forgiveness rather than permission. **Chairman Iorio** stated that he trusts that this is an isolated incident and that they will not have the same issue in the future with any of their other dealerships. **Chairman Iorio** said that he hopes that they will abide by the Resolutions of Approval and Developer's Agreement that are of record which they assumed when they purchased the properties. **Mr. Jaworski** said that he understands his concerns and will convey that back to the applicant.

**Scott Collins, Esq.** of Riker Danzig, One Speedwell Avenue, Morristown, N.J. appeared on behalf of the applicant.

# **TESTIMONY OF ANTHONY ALBANO**

**Anthony Albano** of Stonefield Engineering & Design, 92 Park Place, Rutherford, N.J. was sworn in and deemed an expert in civil engineering. **Mr. Collins** presented Exhibit A-1, Site Plan dated 03/04/19. **Mr. Albano** said that the applicant is proposing lighting upgrades. **Mr. Albano** said they are switching all their light fixtures to LED fixtures. **Mr. Albano** said that they are proposing to install five (5) new poles. **Mr. Albano** said that they are requesting a variance for Lighting Uniformity Ratio where 5.6:1 is proposed and 4:1 is maximum permitted.

#### **BOARD QUESTIONS**

Chairman Iorio asked Mr. Albano the height of the existing wood light poles proposed to be removed. Mr. Albano said they are approximately 14 feet. Chairman Iorio asked Mr. Albano what they are proposing. Mr. Albano said they are proposing four (4) poles at 20 feet high and one (1) pole at 15 feet high. Chairman Iorio asked Mr. Albano if he reviewed Mr. Hals correspondence dated June 21, 2019. Mr. Albano said yes. Chairman Iorio said Mr. Hals commented that the proposed lighting levels can be reduced and still meet the minimum standards for the ATM security lighting and eliminate the need for the variance. Mr. Albano said although Mr. Hals expressed his opinion they think that the current proposal is the optimal design for the bank requirements. Chairman Iorio said that his concern is that the proposed lighting is well above the code requirement and will alter the appearance that currently exists on Main Street. Mr. Collins said that they will try to accommodate the Boards request.

**Mr. Whitaker** said that the application will be carried until September 3, 2019. No new notices are required.
