

**RAMSEY POOL COMMISSION**  
**MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING, WEDNESDAY, JULY 17, 2019**

To date, 2,387 (2,834-2018) families, 376 (389) seniors, 46 (54) individuals, and 437 (337) out-of-towners have registered for the 2019 season, bringing in \$475,000 in comparison with \$506,000 on July 17, 2018.

The storm on Thursday night, July 11<sup>th</sup>, led to a Friday morning closure. The staff worked tirelessly into the night and early Friday morning so that the pool could be cleaned and re-opened for very successful and well-attended Friday programs.
