MINUTES OF MEETING

JULY 20, 2020

Due to COVID-19 restrictions, the July meeting was held via teleconference. The regular meeting of the Ramsey Recreation Commission was called to order by Recreation Director Patterson at 7:34 p.m. Also present were Mrs. Oliver, Mr. Popolo, Mr. Winterhalter, Commissioners, and Council Liaison Gutwetter. Mr. Blasius, Mrs. Fitzgerald, Mr. Jarvis, Mr. Kemp, Mr. Mannion, and Mr. Siraki were absent.

MINUTES

Due to the lack of quorum, approval of the minutes of the February 17, 2020 meeting was tabled.

ACTIVITY REPORTS (OLD/NEW BUSINESS)

Mrs. Oliver reported that the wrestling season did not finish. Three or four wrestlers were going to states but that competition was cancelled as was the end-of-season banquet.

Mr. Popolo has the trophies for the Challenger program. They will be used for the next season. As he did in 2019, he will try to schedule a barbecue at the pool in mid-August as a RIFE activity.

The Ramsey Run was discussed. The \$200 deposit has been paid. Councilman Gutwetter will bring it before the governing body at its next meeting. The status of Ramsey Day is also uncertain.

Whether the Board of Education will allow the use of the high school for the Halloween costume contest is also uncertain as is the status of gym time for basketball and wrestling.

Mr. Patterson has resigned as Recreation Director, effective August 1st. He will be moving to Florida.

An August meeting of some sort will be held if the Ramsey Run will take place.
