Weather Policy: No Camp on Rain Days

Since all the activities of the program take place outdoors, we DO NOT operate in inclement weather. If it rains in the morning, we cancel the day's activities. Please don't bring your children to Finch Park on rainy days. If in doubt, call 201-825-1975 after 7:30 am. A message will be on the tape or check Borough Website

We do not cancel because of heat; however use your good judgement.

If it rains after you drop off your children, or if lightning and/or thunderstorms occur, **COME AND PICK UP YOUR CHILDREN immediately**. There are no sheltered facilities at the park. **Please have arrangements made in advance if you are unable to pick up child. It is important for rain days or if your child should become ill.**

Sunscreen is important! There is very little shade at the park!

Hours of Operations:

Monday – Friday: Drop Off - 9:00 am – 9:15/ Pick Up – 1:40 pm 2:00

Dates of Operation:

Mon-Fri: June 26th – July 28th (No camp on the 3rd and 4th of July!!!)

Lunch Bags: We no longer sell lunch! (Lunch is at 11:30)

Please use insulated bags with an ice pack to keep food fresh. Please Label the outside of the bag.

Clothing: Please dress appropriately for camp!

Bathing suits for “hose play” when weather is hot. Remember white clothes become see-thru when wet. Expect that on hot days kids will get wet! **It is a safety issue!** Sneakers are recommended as well as clothes that can get wet or dirty. **Sandals or flip flops are dangerous for camp (July starts Bee Season).**

NO Cell Phones! If you need to call use the Finch number.

Do not send your child with any valuable items (such as Pokémon cards, tablets, Gameboys, iPods, cell phones etc.) We are not responsible for lost or damaged items. Kids should not bring items to camp! They are a distraction and should be left at home! We don’t want kids sitting around playing with their electronic devices. Camp is for active play!

Drop Off Procedure:

In the morning, please pull up and we will open the door for your child/children. Please do not pull in a parking spot. At dismissal, please pull up, tell us the name of the child and grade they just completed/children you are picking up and we will call their name. Please do not pull in a parking spot, this is dangerous. **If you are going to drop off late or pick up early, you must come inside and sign them in. Don't just drop them off. We need to be aware that they have arrived.** Thank you for your cooperation!

Behavior:

All campers are expected to participate in ALL activities. (Not just those they enjoy most!) It is difficult for the counselors to monitor the kids playing if some are out on the side all the time. Finch Park is a series of fields. Most of the activities are sports related. If your child doesn't like to be active, Finch may not be the best fit! Campers are expected to behave in an appropriate manner and to use proper language. Campers are expected to be respectful to one another as well as to their counselors. We are here to have fun, but not at the expense of others.

If there is a concern, please contact one of the directors as opposed to confronting a counselor. Remember the counselors are high school aged students.
