Right now, if one knows that the Borough is videoing the M&C meetings, they must then know where the link is "hidden". They can go to

- the 'Agenda and Minutes' listing of the December 21 M&C meeting, and see
- "You may also view meeting on Borough Youtube channel, see agenda"
- and then, after waiting for the Agenda to open, one sees
- "View Meeting on Ramsey Youtube Channel
https://www.youtube.com/channel/UCeBnVXBwSn_ILMuAGkSin9w"

It would seem to be easy and courteous, should the Borough wish to have the public aware of the videos and be able to quickly find them,, to posting mention of the videos in a very clear and visible location on the home page. This would eliminate the two extra steps now required.

***Second suggestion*:**

Provide the dates of ALL meeting videos shown on the Borough's youtube channel.

The Council President several times mentioned Wyckoff's video of their meetings. Looking at the Township of Wyckoff youtube channel, all of the Township Council meeting videos have the dates shown.

***Third suggestion*:**

Video and post on the Ramsey youtube channel (In addition to the Mayor and Council), the Planning Board, and Zoning Board of Adjustment meetings,

Wyckoff, which the Council President has used as an example several times, does just that for all three of these most important meetings.

Now, the Planning Board and the Zoning Board of Adjustment currently use Zoom meetings. These meetings require the secretary to use a PC to set up the meeting and to post the graphic information (drawings and photographs) on the Zoom meeting. The Zoom meeting video can be recorded (at no additional cost) on that PC.

The Zoom video of the meeting could then be posted on the Ramsey youtube channels, as the Township of Wyckoff does with their Zoom meetings.

Comment 1

Thanks to the Borough - I've noted that, in the Agendas and Minutes section, the videos are listed for the Mayor and Council, with the Ramsey youtube channel shown at the end of each meeting listing. But there's still NO prominent link on the Ramsey web home page to the Borough's youtube channel.

On the Borough's youtube channel, the meeting dates are now shown for each video, so that the public can identify the one they're looking for.

Suggestion 4

Mention prominently on the web home page that communications and full text of resolutions are now posted as part of the M&C meeting agenda. Including them in the agenda is a step in the right direction; but there's been no mention of it that I've seen since it was started with the November 30, 2020 M&C agenda.

Suggestion 5

The Ramsey website has a "Citizen Request Tracker=C2=AE", but the ONLY use of that is for "Road repairs". Add another use, "Comments to the Mayor and Council", so that folks can easily send comments to the Mayor and Council, without having them lost or misplaced. The "Citizen Request Tracker=C2=AE", is a feature provided by the website vendor, and it should be able to have additional uses easily added.

Suggestion 6

With one of the items of both the M&C Agenda and the M&C Minutes being

"III. COMMUNICATIONS -",

use this for BOTH incoming communications to the Borough, and REPLIES from the Borough to folks who write in. These replies would have the benefit of providing an early and direct response to those folks who write in now and for those who would use the suggested "Comments to the Mayor and Council" feature of the website.

This would improve the communications between the Borough and the public, which is, in the writer's opinion, lacking or - at best - very poor. It would also speed up the M&C meetings a bit for those comments and questions that are addressed before the meeting. As well, it would provide, with an early response, the opportunity for the public, if their request wasn't quite clear, to better present it in the public comment of the meeting.

Doing this would put Ramsey FIRST in providing rapid and public responses to comments and questions.

***Suggestion 7 ***

When the Borough provides a new bit of information, ***let the public know.***

There are several ways of doing that, and i'm sure that the Borough can come up with other ways. But the key points are to

- ***make the information easy to find***, and
- ***let the public know that it's there***.

Some ways include

- posting it on the website at a point where folks go first
- making announcements, in some manner.

There's the Calendar and five other major items shown, there could be another, New Information, or New Features. But don't just list it there, announce it at the meetings, publicize it.

Suggestion 8

Fix and polish up the link the Borough has put a link on the home page to the Mayor and Council videos. There are two significant problems that should be fixed:

- place it in a more obvious place.
 - it's now at the ***very bottom*** of the home page
 - viewer doesn't see it unless they scroll down to the very bottom of the home page
 - when you scroll down to the bottom, ***YouTube*** is very obvious, but ***only*** after you scroll down to the very bottom. One doesn't see it if they go to the major links to ***Calendar***, ***Ordinances***, or ***Minutes & Agendas*** that one sees before getting to ***YouTube link***
- title the link, ***Ramsey meeting videos*** or ***Ramsey video channel*** or similar
- link to the real ***Ramsey Municipal channel*** on youtube
 - present link is to a ***search query***, showing both the Ramsey channel and other videos that just have Ramsey in their titles.

Important Notice Concerning Public Hearing on NBCUA Connection Fees

The Northwest Bergen County Utilities Authority (the "Authority") will conduct a Public Hearing on May 18, 2021 at 7:00p.m. via Zoom, regarding the calculation of connection fees for the calendar year 2021 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:14B-22 and N.J.S.A. 40:14B-23. Details on how to participate in the public hearing are included in the attached meeting notice.


The monies recovered from the connections fees will assist the Authority in minimizing future rate increases to its member municipalities and direct ratepayers. The proposed connection fee requires new connectors to pay their "fair share" of the costs of the existing NBCUA system that has been paid to date by current ratepayers and direct customers of the NBCUA. The Commissioners of the Authority will establish the 2021 connection fee rate at the time of the Public Hearing.

In accordance with the program the NBCUA will annually refund your municipality 15%, up to a \$10,000 maximum per connection, of every new connection fee collected from your municipality.

4. That only those park improvements identified and approved in the project application, its Trust Fund contract, or other documentation will be considered eligible for reimbursement.
5. That the Mayor and Council agrees to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, rules, and regulations in its performance of the project; and,
6. That this resolution shall take effect immediately.
