

# **RAMSEY RECREATION COMMISSION**

## **MINUTES OF MEETING**

**APRIL 17, 2023**

The April meeting was held in person at borough hall; there is no more telephone option. The regular meeting of the Ramsey Recreation Commission was called to order at 7:33 p.m., by Recreation Director Tyburczy. Also present were Mr. Bach, Mr. Jachts, Mr. Jarvis, Mr. Kemp, and Mr. Winterhalter, Commissioners. Mr. Blasius, Mrs. Fitzgerald, Mrs. Oliver, Mr. Siraki, and Council Liaison Gutwetter were absent.

### **MINUTES**

Mr. Jachts moved that the minutes of the March 20, 2023 meeting be approved as received, seconded by Mr. Winterhalter, and passed.

### **ACTIVITY REPORTS (OLD/NEW BUSINESS)**

Regarding the by-laws, the portion which deals with automatic resignation if there are three consecutive unexcused absences was not acceptable. The January and February meetings will be moved so they do not conflict with federal holidays, perhaps having just one meeting in early February. The by-laws will be voted on when finalized.

Someone is needed to run the wrestling program next year.

Finch Park Summer Camp starts on Monday, June 26<sup>th</sup>, to Friday, July 28<sup>th</sup>, with no camp on Monday and Tuesday, July 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>. Mike Kelly will be returning as Camp Director. Online registration will open on Tuesday, April 18<sup>th</sup>. The proposed "Early Bird" fees are \$250 per individual, with a family maximum of \$400. The regular fees are \$275 per individual, with a family maximum of \$450.

Women's softball began on Sunday, April 16<sup>th</sup>. There will be ten games, with playoffs. The fee is \$55 per player, with six teams. Men's softball will be \$975 per team. They also began on Sunday, April 16<sup>th</sup>. There are six teams. Registration is still open for both leagues.

The spring egg hunt had to be cancelled due to inclement weather leading to slippery conditions on the high school lawn. Some people did show up and they were given eggs. The remainder of the eggs went to the Fire Department for their Breakfast with the Easter Bunny and the Touch-a-Truck activity at the Farmers' Market on Sunday. The Halloween activities will also be a Recreation Commission and Fire Department collaboration.

There were further updates to the borough website, including tabs for such information as field locations. Mr. Tyburczy sent out a form to the sports organizations

to gather further information. He is researching vendors who provide facility management.

Everything is ready for the Jim Rogers Memorial which will take place at Finch Park on Saturday, April 29<sup>th</sup>, at 1 p.m.

Home Run Derby is scheduled for Saturday, June 17<sup>th</sup>. Mr. Kemp would like to distribute some paper flyers regarding the event.

The 45<sup>th</sup> Ramsey Run is scheduled for Saturday, September 30<sup>th</sup>. The July meeting is generally cancelled so that any final plans for the Run can be made in August.

There were no questions about the filing of the annual financial disclosure statements with a deadline of April 30<sup>th</sup>.
