MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING, TUESDAY, JUNE 14, 2022

The June meeting of the Pool Commission was called to order on Tuesday, June 14, 2022, rescheduled from Wednesday, June 15, 2022, at 6:05 p.m., by Mr. Bach, Pool Manager.
