

# **RAMSEY RECREATION COMMISSION**

## **MINUTES OF MEETING**

**JUNE 20, 2022**

The June meeting was held in person at borough hall and was also available via teleconference. The regular meeting of the Ramsey Recreation Commission was called to order by Recreation Director Popolo at 7:33 p.m. No one was present via teleconference. Present at borough hall was Mr. Jachts, Commissioner. Mr. Blasius, Mrs. Fitzgerald, Mr. Jarvis, Mr. Kemp, Mrs. Oliver, Mr. Siraki, Mr. Winterhalter, and Council Liaison Gutwetter were absent.

### **PUBLIC HEARING**

Brian Lezette, 154 North Spruce Street, was present to discuss the replacement of the hockey rink at Finch Park with the pickleball courts. He is a Ramsey Hockey Association trustee. He shared the hockey activities which are currently taking place. At this point, he is looking for a fenced cement slab for those children who are looking for a place to play hockey. The tribute to Staff Sergeant Timothy McGill, dedicated on October 19, 2014, should remain displayed at the park, not put in storage.

### **ACTIVITY REPORTS (OLD/NEW BUSINESS)**

Mrs. Dey noted that the by-laws should be in the possession of the governing body for approval.

Ramsey's 50<sup>th</sup> Home Run Derby took place on Saturday, June 18<sup>th</sup>. Ramsey's six overall winners through the years were recognized prior to the 2022 contest. The concession stand was open. The Bradley brothers were given Ramsey Recreation shirts. Approximately fifty boys and girls participated.

The deadline for camp registration was Friday, June 10<sup>th</sup>, extended to Friday, June 17<sup>th</sup>. As of that deadline, 281 campers were registered. Scott Tireman has retired as camp director, replaced by Mike Kelly. He will be assisted by Jessica Hogan and Joe Martinez. The camp payroll was approved.

Women's over 23 softball and Men's over 45 softball are going well.

Both the July and August meetings will be cancelled.

There is a Recreation Commission meeting before the Ramsey Run on Saturday, September 24<sup>th</sup> for any final plans. The bathrooms at the pool will be used rather than the senior center bathrooms. Mrs. Dey will handle the sponsor requests. The registration form will be available via CapturePoint shortly.
