

RAMSEY POOL COMMISSION
MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING, TUESDAY, AUGUST 17, 2022

The August meeting of the Pool Commission was called to order on Wednesday, August 17, 2022 at 8:00 p.m., by Mr. Bach, Pool Manager. Also present were Ms. DeLorenzo, Mr. Jachts, Mr. Jost, and Mrs. Meyer, Commission members, Council Liaison Gutwetter, and Mrs. Dey, Secretary. Mrs. Hewitt, Mrs. Hoffman, and Mrs. Suarez were absent.

In accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey, public notice of the meeting was published in The Record and The Ridgewood News and posted in the Municipal Building.

MINUTES

Upon motion by Mr. Jachts, seconded by Ms. DeLorenzo, the minutes of the July 20, 2022 meeting were approved as received.

REPORT OF THE POOL MANAGER (AGENDA ITEMS)

Mr. Bach shared the latest membership numbers. As of August 17th, there are 2,696 family memberships, 596 out-of-town memberships, and 445 senior memberships, included in the approximately \$754,000 in total payments. In comparison, the total payments for the entire summer were \$619,000 (2021), \$523,000 (2019), and \$532,000 (2018). There has been about six hours of rain so far during the summer. He estimated that it costs approximately \$2,500 per day to run the pool.

Mr. Bach summarized his conversation with Robert Madan during which he explained the details of the rescinded membership.
