

RAMSEY POOL COMMISSION
MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING, TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 21, 2022

The September meeting of the Pool Commission was called to order on Wednesday, September 21, 2022 at 8:00 p.m., by Mrs. Hewitt, Chairman. Also present were Ms. DeLorenzo, Mrs. Hoffman, Mrs. Meyer, and Mrs. Suarez, Commission members, Council Liaison Gutwetter, and Mrs. Dey, Secretary. Mr. Jachts, Mr. Jost, and Mr. Bach, Pool Manager, were absent.

In accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey, public notice of the meeting was published in The Record and The Ridgewood News and posted in the Municipal Building.

REPORT OF THE POOL MANAGER (AGENDA ITEMS)

For the 2022 season, there are 2,696 family memberships, 596 out-of-town memberships, and 445 senior memberships, included in the approximately \$764,000 in total payments. In comparison, the total payments were \$619,000 (2021), \$523,000 (2019), and \$532,000 (2018). The guest fees were \$98,000 in 2022, a significant increase, in comparison with \$84,000 (2021), \$53,000 (2019), and \$58,000 (2018). The 2022 season was an excellent one. It was estimated that it costs approximately \$2,500 to \$3,000 per day to run the pool.
